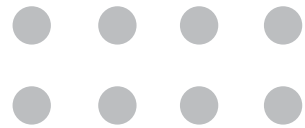
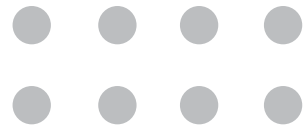

The aerial view lends a sense of perspective that often only distance may provide.





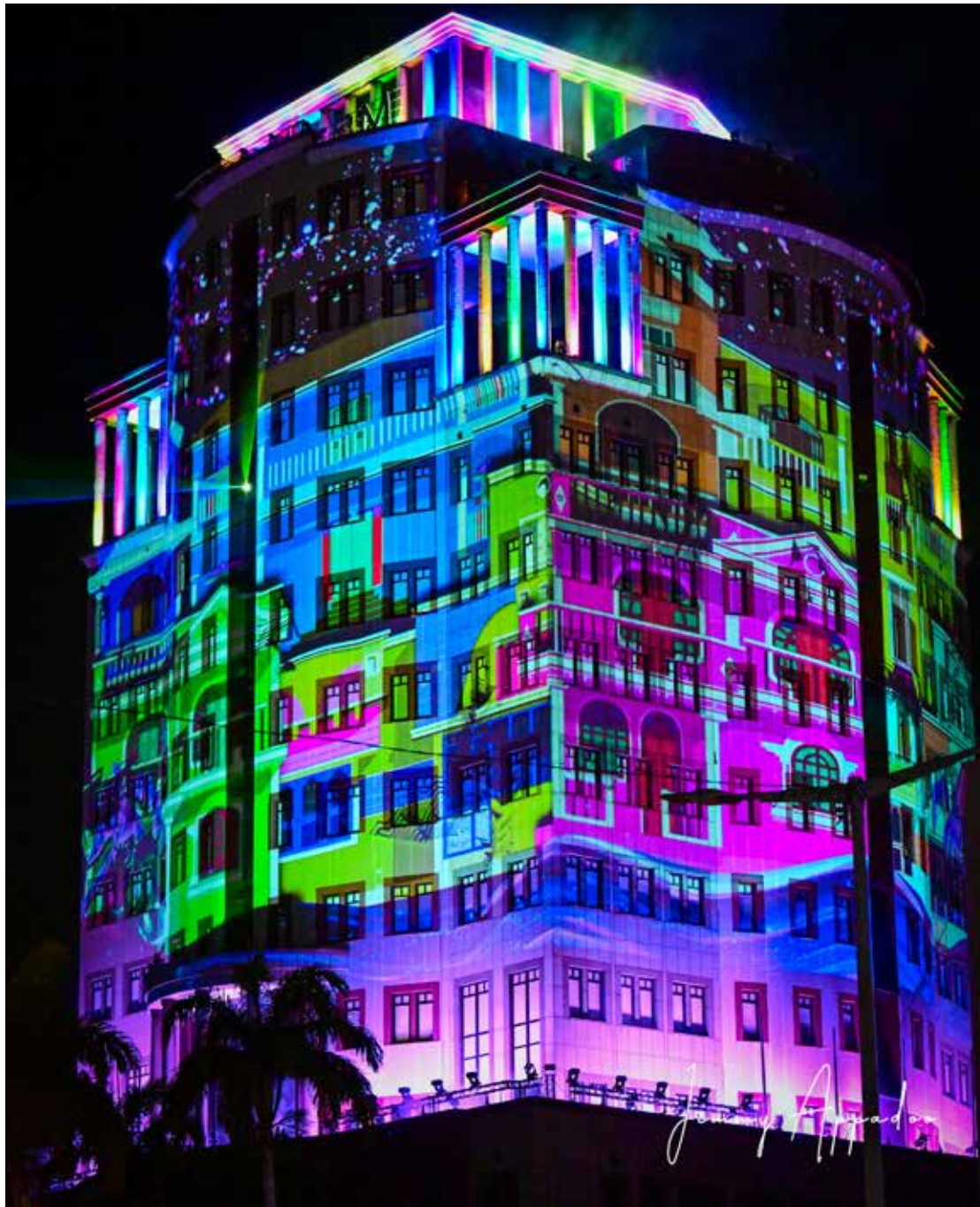

Photography takes an instant out of time, altering life by holding it still





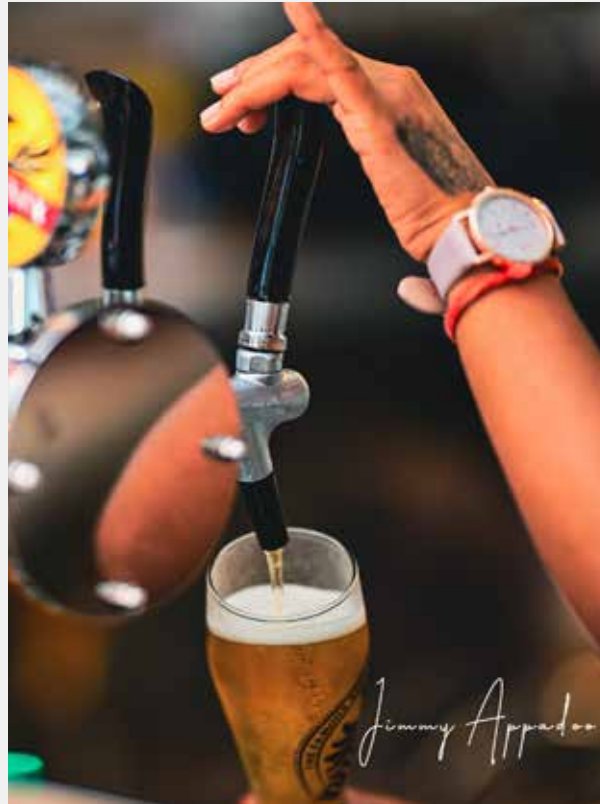
What I like about photographs is that they capture a moment that's gone forever, impossible to reproduce.

A nation's culture resides in the hearts and in the soul of its people" by Mahatma Gandhi.





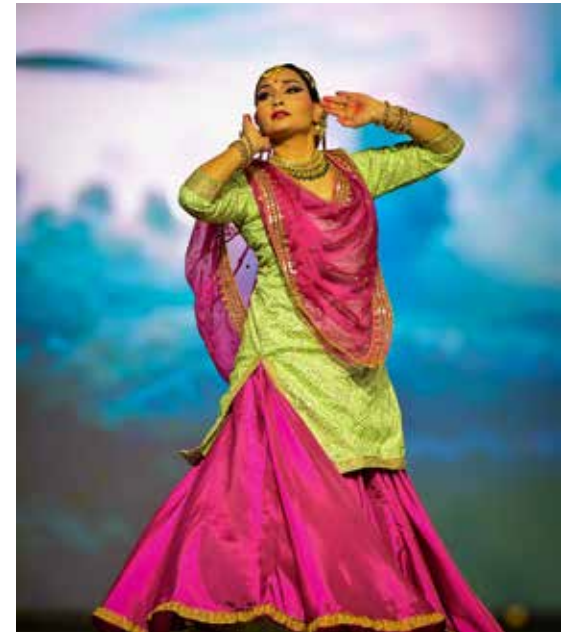
